The status report will be made a part of the docket record. In terms of content, the status report may be brief and should, at a minimum, detail the Working Group's progress so far and summarize unresolved issues and challenges, if any. The status report can also include requests from the Working Group for guidance from the Commission on a particular issue and/or specific questions for the Commission. The Working Group should also be prepared for more detailed discussion and/or documentation, if requested by the Commission.

An agenda will be sent to the Parties in a later communication prior to the Status Conference.

Any written or presentation materials that the Working Group intends to use at the Status Conference must be e-mailed in advance to Commission Staff and all docket parties by **Tuesday, July 26, 2022**. The Working Group should also plan to file its Status Conference materials in the docket immediately following the Status Conference.
